FAIRCLOTHS HEADED TO FLORIDA

Our prayers and best wishes go with Miah, Ollie and Baird Faircloth as they head to Jacksonville, Florida this week for special medical treatments for Ollie. As you may know, Ollie who is 4 years old, has ERMS, Embryonal Rhabdomyosarcoma Cancer. He has been receiving chemo treatments here in Nashville since October of last year. He now will head to the University of Florida in Jacksonville where he will receive Proton Radiotherapy. This radiation is the size of a pencil point and will be aimed directly at Ollie's tumor which is located in the bladder area. This sort of radiation will hopefully protect Ollie's other organs and is considered a better option than regular radiation treatments and surgery at this point.

Miah and the children will be staying at the Ronald McDonald House near the hospital. Treatments will last for 6 ½ weeks. We're sure they would love to hear from you, so feel free to send a letter or card to them at the following address:


