To be honest, I usually learn and grow just as much from camps and retreats as our students do. In fact, there are many times that I return from a youth trip and feel really bad, because I wish that the adults in our congregation could have experienced it with us. So, I thought I could take you along with us into some of the questions that we will be approaching at our first camp this summer, Synodic Camp.

The theme for this year is “Enough” and I would like to take you into the 5 subthemes for each day. With each idea, I will give you a question for you to ponder this week, alongside us.

- 1) Good Enough, Psalm 139:13-18. “You’ve made this day a special day by just your being you. There’s no person in the whole world like you. And I like you just the way you are.” – Fred Rodgers.
What do you need to hear in order to accept yourself the way that God created you?
- 2) Enough is Enough, Matt 14:13-21. “They need not go away; you give them something to eat.”
- Jesus Christ
- 3) God’s Grace is Enough, 2 Cor 12:9. “Forgive us of our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us.”
– The Lord’s Prayer. God’s forgiveness is so great, grace abounds. Are you willing to forgive those who have sinned against you?
- 4) Loved Enough, John 3:16. “Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.” – 1 John 4:7 God has shown us what love looks like, and what love creates in the world. What more can you do to spread love in the world?
- 5) Enough Worries, Matt 6:25-34. “Hacoona Matata” – The Lion King. There are some things that you cannot change, the future marches forward. What is one thing that you should trust God with, and that you can worry less about?

I hope that you have as great of a week diving into these scriptures and questions as we will.
