HERE'S MY HEART

Come, Thou Fount of every blessing, Tune my heart to sing Thy grace

I'm not sure how they do it, but it can happen. Take 4,000-5,000 amped up teenagers, many of whom have traveled hours on a bus, put them in a music hall on the campus of Purdue University, and see if you can get them to sing hymns, pray and listen to a sermon! It happens every 3 years when we have the Presbyterian Youth Triennium. And as always, I come away amazed, blessed and awed by those who have planned, by the numerous volunteers and by the youth who really come to be celebrate their faith in ways that many times they can't.



The theme this year, *Here's My Heart*, was built completely around the hymn, *Come Thou Fount*. A well known hymn written by the 18th-century pastor and hymnist Robert Robinson. He penned the words at age 22 in the year 1757. During the week, we gathered in small groups and unpacked the various statements of faith throughout the hymn. We sang and energized and worshipped and praised God whenever we could get into A/C, since we were living through the hottest week in West Lafayette.

Brenthaven was well represented as Pastors Kip and Sandra served as small group leaders. Jodi Rush served as a Residence Hall Coordinator and Ean and Rhonda chaperoned the 7 youth who attended.

Here I raise my Ebenezer

Have you ever wondered what Robinson meant when he spoke of raising "my Ebenezer"? In 1 Samuel 7:12, the prophet Samuel raises a stone as a monument, saying, "Thus far the LORD has helped us." Samuel gives a name to the stone, *Ebenezer*, meaning Stone of Help. So, in essence this stone of help was a memory stone, for every time they were around it, they could remember.

One of the ways everyone will remember this week was the building of our own Ebenezer, out of 9,000 balloons. Above, you will see the logo for the week. Using 4,000 youth, 9,000 balloons and a lot of fence wire, we recreated that logo and used it for worship on Thursday and Friday. Below is a picture of the finished Ebenezer. Let me just say, I never dreamed it would work out, but it did!



I learned a lesson this week. No matter the size, when everyone works together, even the most outrageously cool things can happen. 4,000 youth will sing an old hymn like it was the best song ever; people will work together to make the most amazing Ebenezers; and God can be blessed in so many ways. It took everyone to make Triennium happen, just like it takes each of YOU to make Brenthaven happen.

Here's my heart, oh, take and seal it; Seal it for Thy courts above.

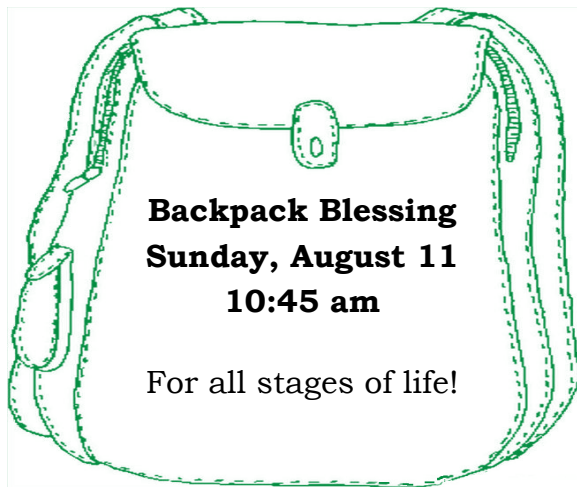
