CALLING ALL YOUTH: SAVE THE DATE!

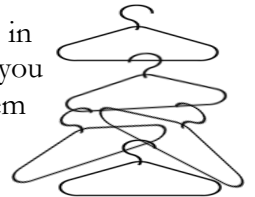
