finish in Trampoline. While doing so she posted personal best scores in Tumbling and Trampoline. Talk about handling the pressure! The competition took place this past week at the *Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympics* in Detroit, Michigan. She qualified through an invitational meet in St. Louis and a regional meet held in Kentucky earlier this year. Corina is part of the *Let It Shine T & T Team*. Proud parents are **Charlie and Kimberly Crowe**.

Proud grandparents are **Hardy & Sandra Moyers** of their granddaughter **Cara Moyers**. Cara recently competed in the *World Jump Rope Championship* in Orlando, Florida. With over 800 competitors from 30 nations, Cara and her team pulled off a Gold Medal in the Speed Relay Event, while Cara tied for the Bronze for all females 16-and under in the world in Individual Freestyle. Cara is part of the *Hot Shots Tennessee Team*,

members of the World Jump Rope Federation. In addition, Cara, age 15, has been accepted as a *World Jump Rope Ambassador* and has been invited to join an elite group of jumpers to travel to Europe spreading the word and love of God through jump rope clinics.
