SUNDAY SCHOOL SCENE

“And one called to another and said, Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of God’s glory.”

Isaiah 6:3

The students in the *Workshop Rotation Sunday School Classes* begin a new year of study this Sunday with their focus being “Worship and the Church Year.” Their studies will include the Season of Advent, Season of Christmas, Season of Lent and Easter, etc. They will begin this month focusing on *Elements of Worship*.

Worship styles differ in Christian churches throughout the world. In the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, this is no different. Go to any CP Church and the worship services will vary. In general, the four basic elements of worship are prayer, the word of God, sacraments and music. So why do we do what we do? What is the difference between Gloria Patri and the Doxology? Why is there communion just once a month? What is the Baptismal, and why do the colors of the paraments change, and exactly, what is a parament?

The children will begin with *The Elements of Worship*. **Rev. Sandra** will start off in the *Oasis Workshop* by using our church bulletin to discover the ways scripture and prayer are used in worship. **Pastor Kip** will check in with the children to explain how he picks Bible verses and writes his sermon. **Linda Pulley** will lead the *Joyful Noise Workshop* and explain how hymns are selected, what is involved in being in the Choir, what is an “anthem” or a “response song.” **Becky Jones** will tour the sanctuary with the children, explaining the chancel, the communion table, and why there is a silver pitcher and chalice. The children will then pick their favorite object and draw a picture to keep in their journals.

These classes are for children in Kindergarten through 6th grade and begin each Sunday at 9:30 am in the Children’s Wing. Please contact **Cheryl Morris**, Children’s Ministry, if you have any questions.

ELECTRONIC (ONLINE) GIVING
