OVERSEAS MISSION TRIP OPPORTUNITY FOR ADULTS

The Missions Ministry Team of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church is hosting an opportunity for mission to support the ministry of the CP Church in **Mata de Sao Joao, Brazil** through leading activities with local children and youth during a week-long camp. The Cumberland Presbyterian Church has been present in Brazil for 50 years. Japan Presbytery has sent many missionaries in the past and for the first time in Cumberland Presbyterian history, the Missions Ministry Team is planning on sending the first North American missionaries to Brazil. The group will be made up of 10-15 adults who enjoy working with children and youth and who are interested in learning more about the ministry of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church around the world. Milton Ortiz and Jodi Rush are serving as leaders for this trip. Specific details are:

Where: **Salvador, Brazil and Mata de Sao Joao, Brazil**

When: **January 20-30, 2017**

How Much: **\$3,500 (plus flight to/from Miami)**

The Missions Ministry Team will provide a sample letter to request financial support from your church and friends.
