## MISSION TRIP: APPALACHIA SERVICE PROJECT

Greetings from Youth ROCKS, Brenthaven's Youth Ministry! We hope you are well and enjoying the blessings of God. We would like to share with you, our Brenthaven family, our plans for the mission trip this summer and how you can help us get there.

June 8th–15th, we will be hitting the road to serve alongside the **Appalachia Service Project.** ASP is a Christian ministry, open to all people, that inspires hope and service through volunteer home repair and replacement in Central Appalachia. They have served communities in Tennessee, Kentucky, Virginia, West Virginia, and North Carolina since 1969, seeking to make their homes warmer, safer, and drier. 
ASP addresses these concerns in various ways, including facilitating home repair, employing college-aged Appalachia natives as team leaders, and educating service groups on the experience of those who live within ASP's service area. On our trip we will be working alongside them to BUILD a better environment for low income and impoverished families through construction projects, such as porches, ramps, roofing, drywall, siding, floors, and foundations.

How you can help: if you feel called to partner with us for this mission trip, here are some ways you can help.

**Pray.** Please pray that we prepare ourselves to be open to the word of God proclaimed through the lives of those we encounter.
