# A NEW AND GLORIOUS MORN! CELEBRATING THE LIGHT AND LIFE OF CHRISTMAS

Each August, when summer is coming to an end, and temperatures in Nashville are normally in the eighties, I begin the search for a Christmas cantata for the choir. While there are many talented composers and arrangers who produce various cantatas, I sometimes feel like Goldilocks searching for the one that is "just right" for our choir and congregation.

This year we will be singing A New and Glorious Morn! by Lloyd Larson on Sunday morning, December 17th. I'd like to share with you the Foreword in our cantata.

In recent months I had the opportunity to experience one of my bucket-list trips: a visit to Israel, the Holy Land. Following that trip of a lifetime, I returned home with the plan to tackle this Christmas musical. As I sat down to write the music and craft the narrative script, I could not help but find myself mentally returning to Bethlehem, to sites I had visited that are believed to have been the locations where Jesus was born and where Judean shepherds received the angelic news about the Messiah's birth.

The incarnation story never grows old. The fact that God would choose to descend from the heights of heaven to dwell among us through Jesus is truly a remarkable realization for me, as I suspect it is for all believers. That miraculous event is indelibly imprinted on my heart and mind as a result of my recent visit to Israel.

A New and Glorious Morn! focuses on the reality that in Christ the old is gone and all things are made new. (II Cor. 5:17) Old Testament Israel had yearned for the promised Messiah for generations. When Jesus came, it wasn't how they had envisioned God's redemption plan would unfold. Yet, it followed the prophets' road map to a T as He was divinely conceived and born in the tiny village of Bethlehem. With His birth came the promise of a new day of hope and life for those who embraced God's message through this newborn King.

But the dawning of this new day of promise did not end with the life and death of Jesus. It continues through the generations to each of us as we anticipate the fulfillment of His second Advent—the return of the conquering King—when He will one day take us home to live in a place where there will be no more darkness, where the Lord God will be the source of everlasting light!

Through a blending of new and familiar lyrics and ageless melodies, I pray that singers, instrumentalists, and congregations alike will experience anew the reality of God's incomparable love. The birth of Jesus is not just a series of historical events discovered in the archaeological findings of Israel. It is experiencing the reality of His love through the embrace of a child, the legacy of an elderly saint, and a cup of water offered in love. In each of these acts we experience the reality of the Christmas message and the promise of an eternal day that is yet to come! —Lloyd Larson

I pray that as you worship with us on December 17th, you experience the birth of Jesus anew, through song and word. Wishing you a joyous Advent and Christmas season as we celebrate together the first and most precious Christmas gift, Jesus.
