#### THE PURPOSE OF LENT

As you read this, the season of Lent has begun. What that means, of course, is a 40-day season (plus the Sundays within it) set aside by Christians for the purpose of preparing for the celebration of Christ's resurrection by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. I can almost hear some of you wondering what's supposed to be in that blank. The challenge is for *you* to fill in the blank.

In the great scheme of things, Lent is seen as a time of repentance (regret, sorrow, remorse, atonement) and almsgiving (charity, sharing of resources, service to others). It is a time of seeking choices that help us to grow closer to Christ—a time to be intentional about following his example more carefully. Many people focus on prayer, reading of scripture, and/or serving others. Some abstain from things that tend to weaken their bodies, their sense of wholeness, or their ability to live as examples of faith in Christ. Others look for examples of kindness and selflessness, using those examples to encourage themselves to do the same.

Now, back to the blank in the first paragraph. My challenge for you today is to seriously, prayerfully consider how God is calling YOU to spend Lent this year. Are you called to abstain from something? Are you called to join something? Are you called to pray regularly about how to right the wrongs you see? Are you called to some sort of service to others? Are you called to build bridges in relationships? Are you called to encourage someone who could really use an ally? Are you called to deep study of a particular facet of your faith?

In whatever way God is calling you to spend Lent this year, I pray God will bless you (and me) with the strength and commitment to follow that path throughout the season. Maybe, just maybe, we'll be developing some new habits that can keep us grounded in our faith and growing ever closer to our amazing Lord! Grace and peace,


