HYMNS AND SONGS OF FAITH

It's amazing how much connection we feel to certain hymns and songs. There are hymns that we never tire of singing. I've actually had folks tell me that they would be happy to sing their favorite hymn every Sunday. While I realize that there are those special hymns that have meant so much to so many for as long as they can remember, we would do a disservice not to introduce new hymns and songs of faith in our services, whether sung as a congregation or as special music. One such piece is *Will You Come and Follow Me*, sometimes known as *The Summons*, written by John L. Bell in 1987.

John L. Bell was born in the Scottish town of Kilmarnock in Ayrshire, intending to be a music teacher prior to feeling the call to the ministry. He did volunteer work in deprived neighborhoods in London and served for two years as an associate pastor at the English Reformed Church in Amsterdam. He worked for five years as a youth pastor for the Church of Scotland, serving a large region that included about 500 churches. He then took a similar position with the Iona Community, and began to broaden the youth ministry to focus on renewal of the church's worship. He began to compose songs within the identifiable traditions of hymnody that address some of the concerns missing from the traditional Scottish hymnal.

In Bell's words, "I discovered that seldom did our hymns represent the plight of the poor people to God. There was nothing that dealt with unemployment, nothing that dealt with living in a multicultural society and feeling disenfranchised. There was nothing about child abuse. Nothing that helped see ourselves as brothers and sisters to those who are suffering from poverty or persecution."

This concern of Bell's led him not only to compose many songs but to introduce them internationally in many conferences.

As we ponder the powerful, and sometimes stinging words of this song, may it be our mission this Lenten season, and all seasons, to strive to live as Christ would have us to live, responding to His summons with true devotion.

The Summons

"Will you come and follow Me, if I but call your name? Will you go where you don't know and never be the same? Will you let My love be shown? Will you let My name be known? Will you let My life be grown in you, and you in Me?"

"Will you leave yourself behind, if I but call your name? Will you care for cruel and kind, and never be the same? Will you risk the hostile stare, should your life attract or scare? Will you let Me answer pray'r in you, and you in Me?"

"Will you let the blinded see, if I but call your name? Will you set the prisoners free, and never be the same? Will you kiss the leper clean, and do such as this unseen, and admit to what I mean in you, and you in Me?"

"Will you love the 'you' you hide, if I but call your name? Will you quell the fear inside, and never be the same? Will you use the faith you've found to reshape the world around, through My sight and touch and sound in you and you, in Me?"

"Lord, Your summons echoes true, when You but call my name. Let me turn and follow You, and never be the same. In Your company, I'll go where Your love and footsteps show. Thus I'll move and live and grow in You, and You in me."

"I will move and live and grow in You, and You in me."

May we truly move and live and grow in Christ.
